



There is an attached garage at the north end of the house. A wood wheelchair ramp leads to the front door. The front door and windows appear to be modern replacements.</b>				
43. History and Significance (Continue on Reverse if necessary) <b>This house is part of a small pocket of residential development that was constructed between the mid-1950s and mid-1960s. Most of the houses had been constructed before the announcement of plans to expand the Armco steel mill into the land to the west of the houses. Rockford Map Publishers' 1958 county atlas labels the area of Harkie Street as the Sunny Acres Subdivision.</b>				
44. Description of Environment and Outbuildings (See #52) <b>Harkie Street is a residential cul-de-sac lined with ranch houses and a few ranch-type duplexes. Oxford State Road in this area is a busy four lane divided road. The surrounding area is largely commercial and industrial in character. Other than Harkie Street and two houses at its intersection with Oxford State Road, there are no other residences in the area.</b>
