




The northern two bays, the front door and a picture window, are sheltered within a front-gabled porch. The porch has a concrete deck and wood posts. 43. History and Significance (Continue on Reverse if necessary) This house is part of a small pocket of residential development that was constructed between the mid-1950s and mid-1960s. Most of the houses had been constructed before the announcement of plans to expand the Armco steel mill into the land to the west of the houses. 44. Description of Environment and Outbuildings (See #52) This house has a detached garage located at the northwest corner of the house. There is no longer a garage door; the east (front) wall of the garage has been covered with siding and a picture window installed. Harkie Street is a residential cul-de-sac lined with ranch houses and a few ranch-type duplexes. Oxford State Road in this area is a busy four lane divided road.
