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

42. Further Description of Important Interior and Exterior Features (Continued on Reverse if Necessary)
2921 Harkie Street is a ranch house. An attached garage is at the south end of the house, but the former doorway has been filled with siding and a picture window. This house is one of only a few on the street to have a chimney visible. The brick chimney is located at the junction of the house and former garage. A shed roof porch extends from the rear of the garage. A stoop and hood are located at the front door. The aluminum-frame windows are original.

43. History and Significance (Continue on Reverse if necessary)
This house is part of a small pocket of residential development that was constructed between the mid-1950s and mid-1960s. Most of the houses had been constructed before the announcement of plans to expand the Armco steel mill into the land to the west of the houses. Rockford Map Publishers' 1958 county atlas labels the area of Harkie Street as the Sunny Acres Subdivision.

44. Description of Environment and Outbuildings (See #52)
A one-and-one-half-story, two bay, gambrel roof detached garage is located northeast of the house. Harkie Street is a residential cul-de-sac lined with ranch houses and a few ranch-type duplexes. Oxford State Road in this area is a busy four lane divided road. The surrounding area is largely commercial and industrial in character. Other than Harkie Street and two houses at its intersection with Oxford State Road, there are no other residences in the area.
