42. Further Description of Important Interior and Exterior Features (Continued on Reverse if Necessary)  
**2920 Harkie Street is a ranch house. The southernmost bay is an original aluminum frame picture window consisting of a center panel flanked by double hung windows. The front door is original, as are the two horizontal sliding windows located south of the door. A shed roof porch is located off the north end of the rear of the house. The end walls also have horizontal sliding windows.**

43. History and Significance (Continue on Reverse if necessary)  
**This house is part of a small pocket of residential development that was constructed between the mid-1950s and mid-1960s. Most of the houses had been constructed before the announcement of plans to expand the Armco steel mill into the land to the west of the houses. Rockford Map Publishers' 1958 county atlas labels the area of Harkie Street as the Sunny Acres Subdivision.**

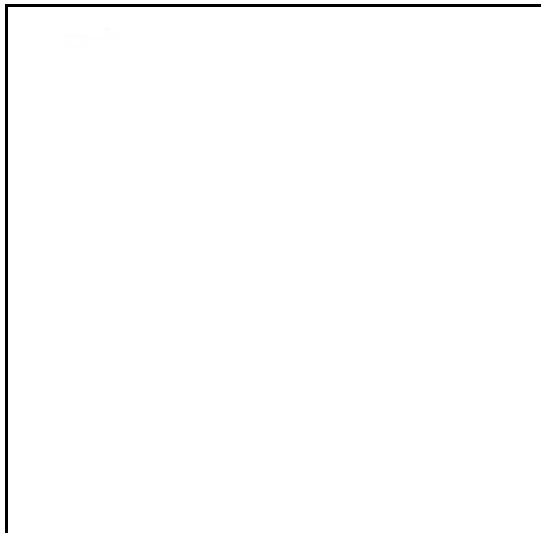
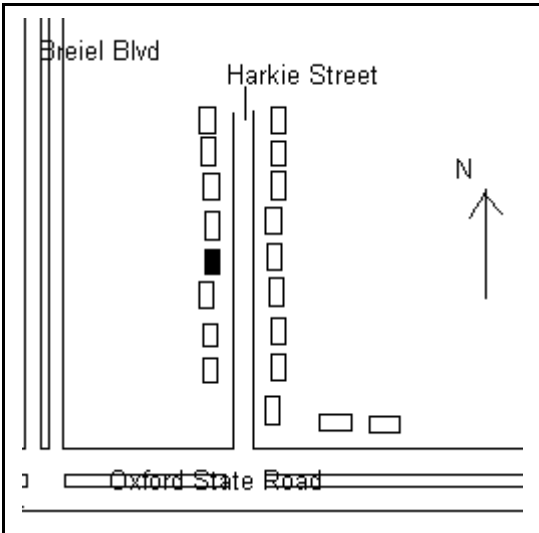
44. Description of Environment and Outbuildings (See #52)  
**A detached garage is located at the northwest corner of the house. The garage has a modern replacement garage door. Harkie Street is a residential cul-de-sac lined with ranch houses and a few ranch-type duplexes. Oxford State Road in this area is a busy four lane divided road. The surrounding area is largely commercial and industrial in character. Other than Harkie Street and two houses at its intersection with Oxford State Road, there are no other residences in the area.**
