



<p>2914 Harkie Street is a ranch house. A carport has been added to the south end of the house, and a porch, continuous from the carport, extends north across the southern two bays of the facade. The two bays sheltered within the porch are a picture window and the front door. The current porch is clearly not original, although the location of the porch may be, as porches in a similar location are found on other houses along the street. The horizontal sliding windows north of the porch are replacements.</p>				
43. History and Significance (Continue on Reverse if necessary)				
<p>This house is part of a small pocket of residential development that was constructed between the mid-1950s and mid-1960s. Most of the houses had been constructed before the announcement of plans to expand the Armco steel mill into the land to the west of the houses. Rockford Map Publishers' 1958 county atlas labels the area of Harkie Street as the Sunny Acres Subdivision.</p>				
44. Description of Environment and Outbuildings (See #52)				
<p>Harkie Street is a residential cul-de-sac lined with ranch houses and a few ranch-type duplexes. Oxford State Road in this area is a busy four lane divided road. The surrounding area is largely commercial and industrial in character. Other than Harkie Street and two houses at its intersection with Oxford State Road, there are no other residences in the area.</p>
