

Painted aluminum screen above door and windows on front facade. Suspended cylindrical flank portal. Stylized eagle surmounts stepped-parapet at top of building. Portal soffit has three dimensional vine of floral motif. Doorway altered with new aluminum doors. Interior marbled lobby unaltered except for dropped ceiling. <p>43. History and Significance (over)</p> <p>The Second National Bank was organized in 1865. Its 1909 officers were prominent citizens of Hamilton, including George and Charles Sohngen, Charles and John Heiser, and Oakley V. Parrish. This building was constructed in 1931 and is a fine example of the Art Deco style</p>
