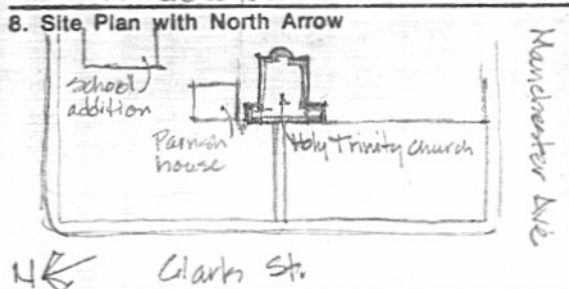

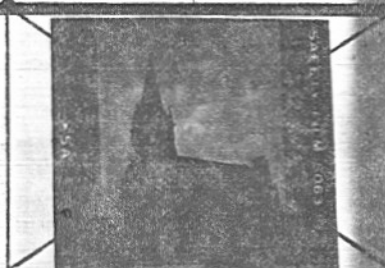

42. Further Description of Important Features  
The foundation and walls are of rock faced sandstone. There are 2-story stained glass windows on 3 sides of the church and an apse at the east end. There is a spire on the south west corner and a large round arched entrance with oak doors. The additions include a porch on the south-west corner, and an entrance way on the northwest corner next to the parish house.



43. History and Significance  
First Catholic Church established in Middletown.  
This block is to become part of a housing complex for the elderly - old buildings will be restored and new apartment buildings will be built.

44. Description of Environment and Outbuildings  
The parish house to the north is a circa 1900 white stucco house with a large front porch. Holy Trinity Catholic school was located on the northeast corner of the church-owned block, an addition to that structure still remains.
