

43. History and Significance (Continue on reverse if necessary) The building survives in a good state of preservation, with many of its original features intact. It is distinguished by its unusual parapet gable form and curved roof. Otherwise it is a typical storage building of the type often erected in the 1940's and the 1950's.					
44. Description of Environment and Outbuildings (See #52) The armory is located on S. Main St. on this large corner lot, but this building stands perhaps a few hundred feet southwest of it, facing onto a side road. Its site borders a broad levee along the Great Miami River.
