IN 1879 the firm of Reutti & Mason leased the Schelly malt house on Canal Street between Sixth and Seventh. The house had a capacity of one hundred thousand bushels and this firm increased it to one hundred and fifty thousand. In 1879 the business was purchased by Charles Sohngen, George P. Sohngen and William B. Brown, who conduct the business under the name of The Hamilton Malting Co. The product of this malt house is marketed through the Sohngen Malting Company.
