

# THE Sohngsn and Brown Co.

Manufacturers of Maize Malt.

THE old Canal Mill, at the head of Dayton Street on the Canal, had been idle, and in 1888 The Sohngen & Brown Company was incorporated with a capital of twenty thousand dollars, with Charles Sohngen, President, William B. Brown, Vice President, and George P. Sohngen, Secretary and Treasurer. The old mill was completely cleaned out and entirely new machinery put in, adapted for the manufacturing of maize malt. The work is done by roller-mills entirely and two thousand bushels of corn per day are ground and the product is sold in New York, Philadelphia, and the East generally. Mr. Brown runs the business at the mill and the office is with the Sohngen Malting Co., corner of C and Franklin streets.
